

The Exchange Control in Thessaloniki

1931-1941 and 1947-1959

The «Exchange Control» for the incoming and outgoing mail to Greece can be considered as a routine business for the post office. It was implemented for the first time during the 1st World War as a «financial control», but was not used in Thessaloniki.

Thessaloniki is the second most important city of Greece. It is built in the inlet of Thermaikos Gulf, in the North-Western part of the Aegean Sea.

On October 8th, 1931, with a law published in the 354/A' sheet of the Government Gazette, the "Foreign Exchange Control" began in Thessaloniki, with the control of the content of the registered letters to abroad as to whether it contained banknotes. On August 20, 1936, selective control of simple and registered letters going abroad began, and gradually until January 6, 1937 it became mandatory for all outgoing and incoming correspondence. At the same time, the control did not only concern their content in foreign currency but also took the form of censorship of their text. On October 28th, 1940, due to the declaration of the Greek-Italian war, the control of foreign exchange was formally stopped, but in fact it continued through the censorship due to the war. The "Foreign Exchange Control" stopped on April 9th with the occupation of Thessaloniki by the German occupying forces. On May 20th, 1947, the control over foreign exchange content started again only in the registered mail abroad. On July 13th, 1948 it was extended to plain mail. The lifting of foreign exchange control took place on October 25th, 1951. However, a few days later, in early November, 1951, it resumed, but only for letters registered abroad. This virtually faded in the late 1950s.

On September 28th, 1931, the compulsory law "On the Protection of the National Currency" was published in the 335/A' issue of the Government Gazette, which stated that during its validity, the sale and purchase of gold, foreign currency and foreign banknotes, is monopolized by the Bank of Greece.

On **October 8th, 1931**, a supplement to the previous law was published in the 354/A' issue of the Government Gazette. In the first article it was stated: "It is forbidden to export banknotes (Greek or foreign currencies) or bank checks without the permission of the Bank of Greece. Also, any registered letters or parcels sent abroad are delivered open to the post office and will be sealed before the postman who receives them after verifying that they do not contain any value".

Thus began the control of foreign exchange in Greece.

This law remained in force until August 19, 1936.

Ἄρθρον 4.

The Exchange Control in Thessaloniki - 1st period 1931-1936

In this first period the envelopes after checking and closing them, were stamped as «ΕΞΗΛΕΓΧΘΗ» (Checked) and then forwarded to their recipient abroad. There was no control over what was written in the letters.

During this period, two different types of cancel were used.

The Exchange Control in Thessaloniki - 2nd period 1936-1940

On August 4th, 1936, the "Proclamation of Martial Law in Greece" by King George II was published in the 324/A' issue of the Government Gazette, following a proposal by Prime Minister I. Metaxas. A few days later the secrecy of the letters was lifted.

On August 20th, 1936, the circular order 335307 of the Hellenic Post was issued towards ten post offices of the country, including the one of Thessaloniki, which concerned the selective control of foreign simple and registered letters for their content, by employees of the Bank of Greece, in the presence of a competent postal employee. The extend of the mail check was determined by the bank clerk.

On August 21, 1936, the new compulsory law no. 33.1936 "on filling up previous series of laws (1931/1935) of Protection of National Currency", was published in the 364/A issue of the Government Gazette, with the result of Foreign Exchange Control Committees creation.

On September 15, 1936, selective control was extended to incoming mail from abroad.

From September 25, 1936, all outgoing letters, as well as from January 6, 1937 all outgoing and incoming letters, whether they have checked or not, would have to bear the special foreign exchange control cancels, otherwise they could not be sealed in shipping bags.

The small post offices did not check the letters submitted (except in very rare cases) because this work belonged to the exchange control services that were initially installed in the exchange offices and later in other large couriers country offices. Throughout the 2nd period, the texts of the letters were checked at the same time

On October 28, 1940, the compulsory law 2606/1940 "on declaring the Territory under siege" was published in the 338/A' issue of the Government Gazette, and the Greek-Italian war began. The foreign exchange check formally expired that day.

From the 20th of August 1936 until the 28th of October 1940, when the exchange control stopped due to the beginning of the Greek-Italian war, the following types of cancel were used in the central post office of Thessaloniki in the order of their use and for the respective periods known until today:

2.1 The use of the second type of the ΕΞΗΛΕΓΧΘΗ (Checked) cancel of the previous period continued for about three months in parallel with the normal foreign exchange control cancel.

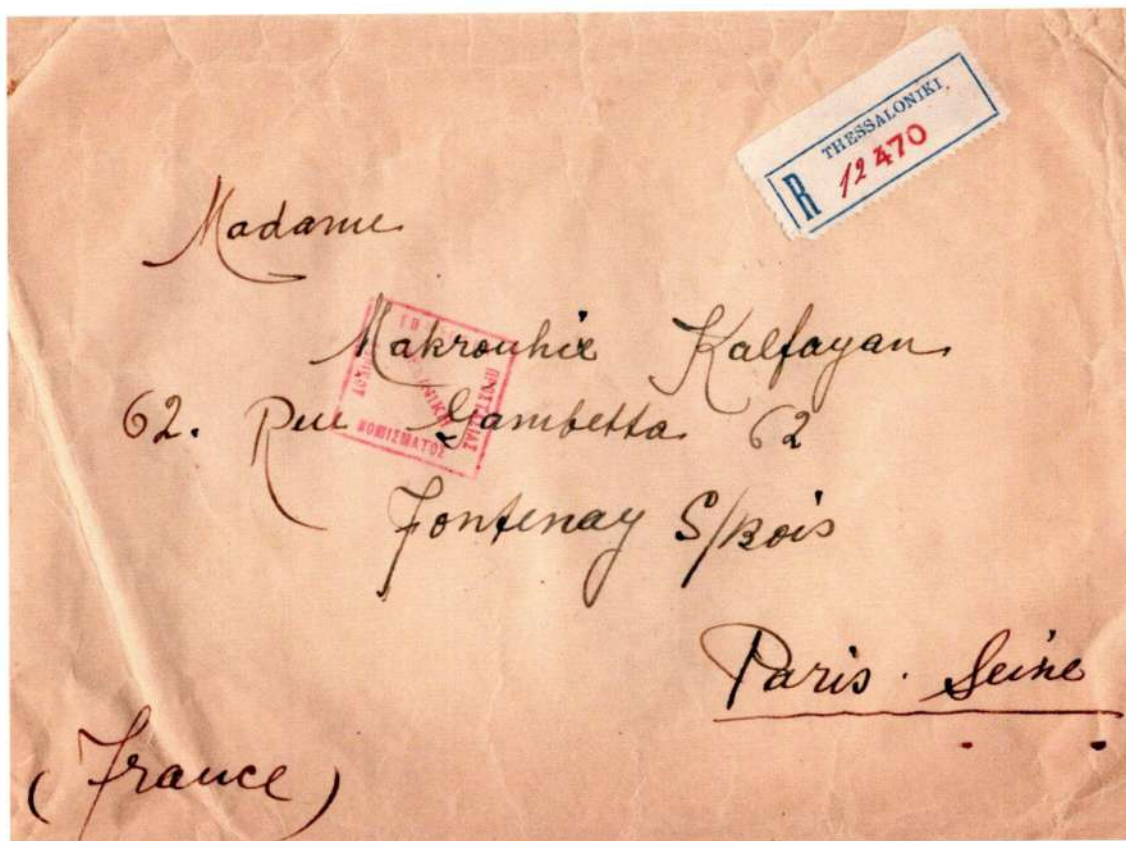

2.2 The first new type of cancel used immediately after the imposition of an audit on 20 August, bore only the word "Bank of Greece" in Greek and had no reference to an audit. This type remained in use until November 1936.

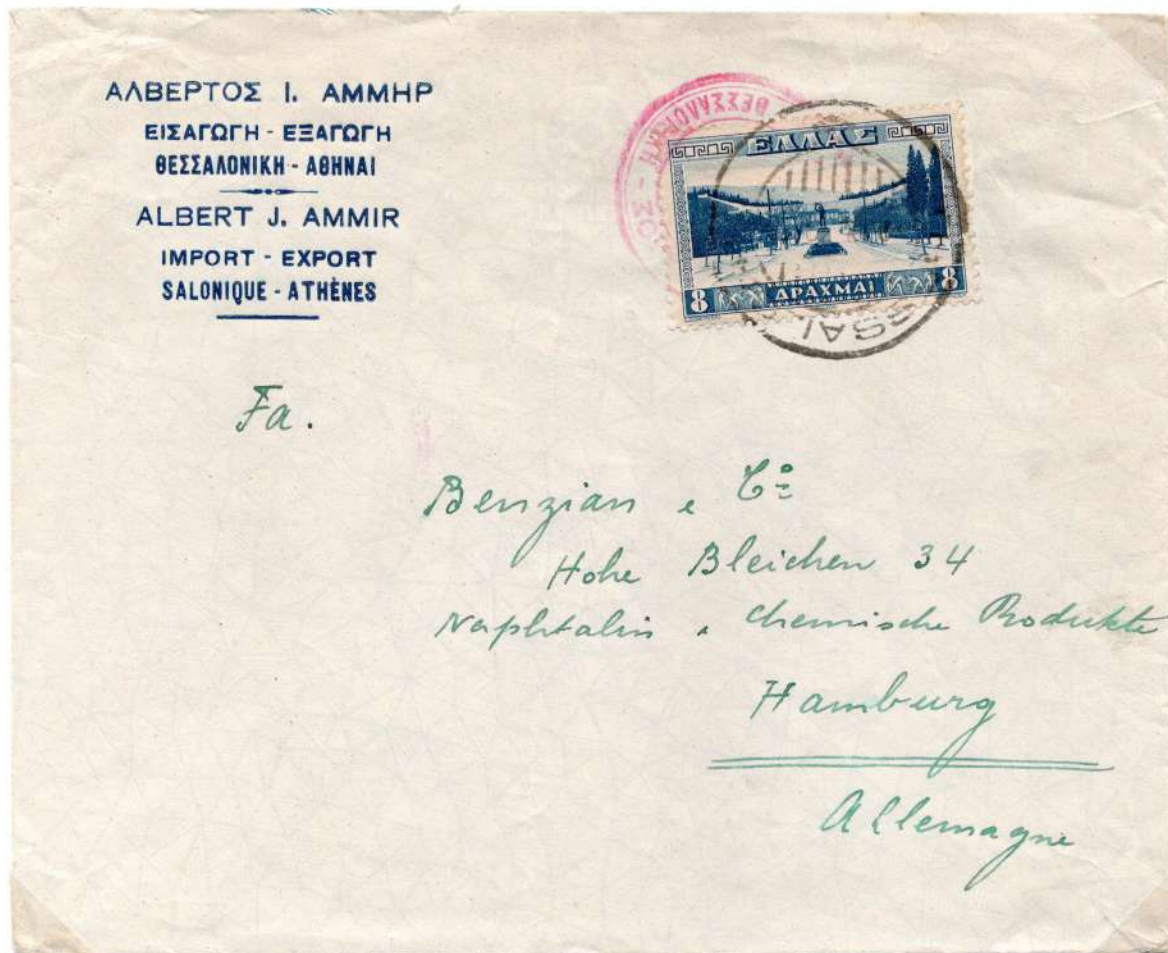

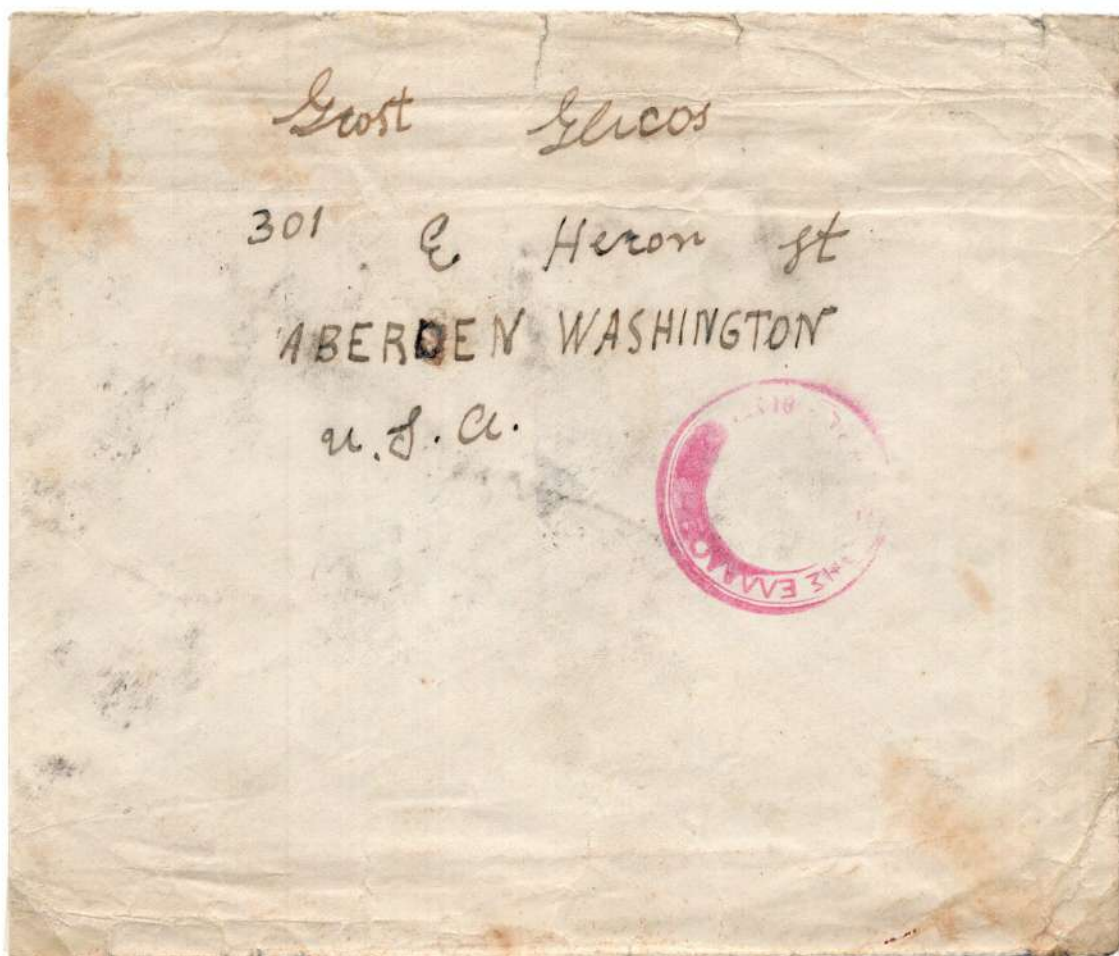

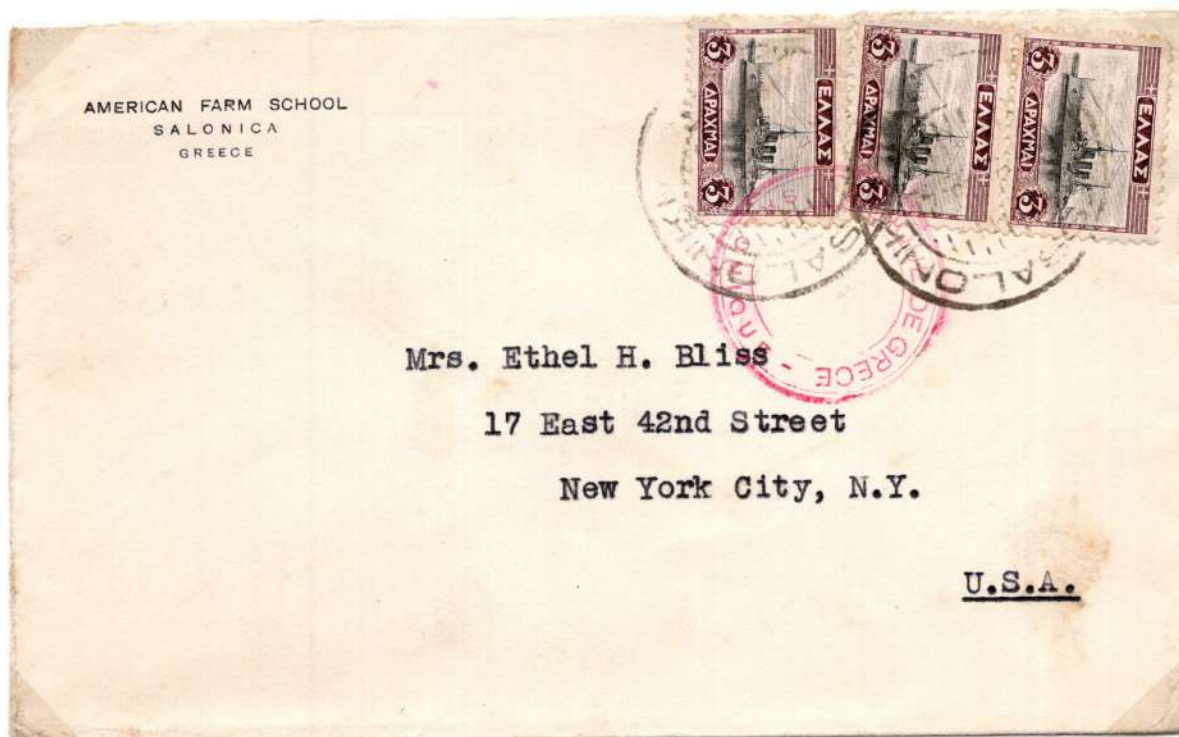

2.3 Simultaneously with the previous type of cancel, a similar one was used which was marked "Bank of Greece" in French. This type remained in use for only one month.

2.4 A new type of "Bank of Greece" cancel bearing for the first time the indication "Control" was used for only about five days in the second ten days of September 1936.

The Exchange Control in Thessaloniki - 3rd period 1940-1941

Immediately after the start of the Greek-Italian war on October 28, 1940, foreign exchange control formally ceased. However, the censorship of the correspondence began that lasted until April 9, 1941, when Thessaloniki was occupied by the German forces.

On November 18, 1940, Circular 256418 of the Hellenic Post Office was issued "on the censorship of mail and parcels" which, despite its title, referred to the actions of the Postal Service in case of finding a sum of money in letters. So immediately the exchange rate control continued.

During this period the registered items were controlled by censorship and all outgoing letters were opened in order to be censored. If the censor found foreign currency in the file, then after the check a relevant note or special stamp was entered in which the contents of the file were recorded and signed by the competent officials. The envelope was then sealed with tape and forwarded to the recipient.

On May 20, 1947, the order 71733)2)SYN was issued, based on which the sender of mail was obliged to deliver to the post office personally the registered mail and parcels open that was headed abroad. After the postman examined them that they did not contain banknotes (Greek or foreign currencies) or checks, etc., the items were closed by the sender himself and at the closing point were marked by hand or with a stamp marked «ΗΛΕΓΧΘΗ» (checked) and monograph of post employee. If there was something inside that was not allowed, then the post officer was requesting the assistance of the branch of the Bank of Greece. The text of the letters was not checked. This obligation ceased when foreign exchange control began in July 1948.

The Exchange Control in Thessaloniki - 5th period 1948-1951

On July 13, 1948, the legislative decree "On the establishment of committees for the Protection of the National Currency" was published in the 182th issue of the Government Gazette, which aimed at controlling the correspondence that going only abroad and preventing currency escape. All letters were submitted to the post office closed. No foreign exchange control was done on correspondence arriving from abroad. Mail control at this time did not play a censorship role. In simple letters, the audit was carried out at the discretion of the Commission, in whole or in a fixed percentage. On the contrary, registered letters, as well as parcels and small parcels, were checked by the Commission without exception. With the decree "On the repeal of the legislative decree of 1948 on foreign exchange control" published on October 25, 1951 in the 284th issue of the Government Gazette, the control of foreign exchange in all outgoing simple and registered letters was stopped.

All postal items sent abroad had to have a foreign exchange control cancel. Those that were not opened to check their contents were given one of the following four cancels.

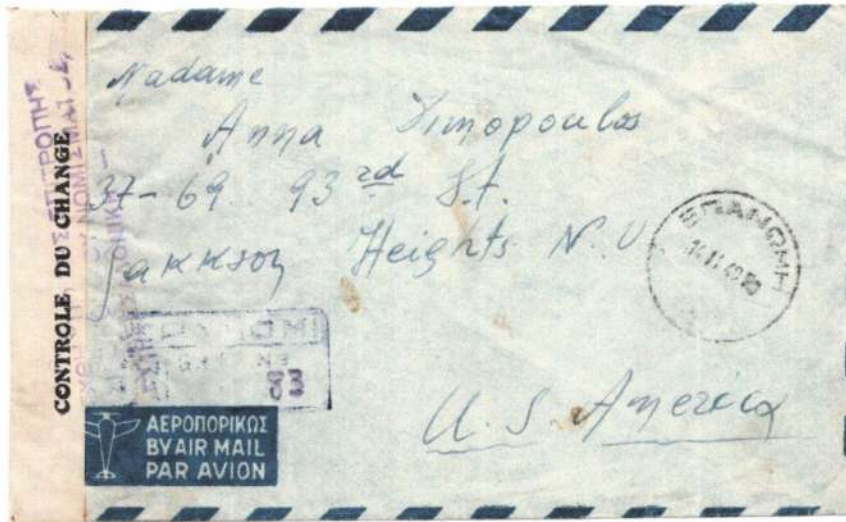

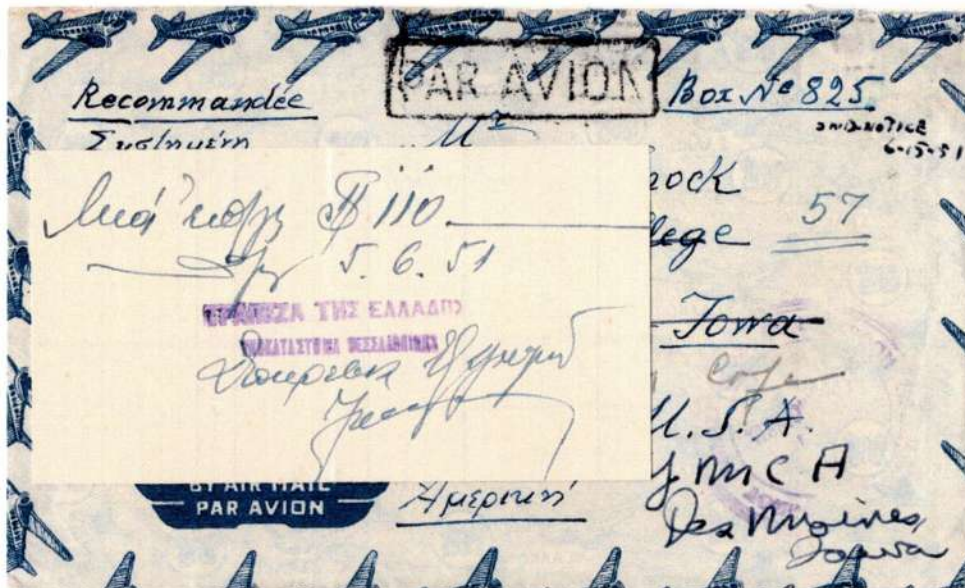

After the lifting of the exchange control on October 25, 1951, with the order number 83811 / .11.1951 of the post offices, the order 71733)2) SYN / 20.5.1947 came into force again according to which only the registered letters had to be deposited open and checked for foreign exchange. After their examination by the competent officials, the file was closed and a stamp with the indication CHECKED was inserted at the closing point. This virtually faded in the late 1950s.

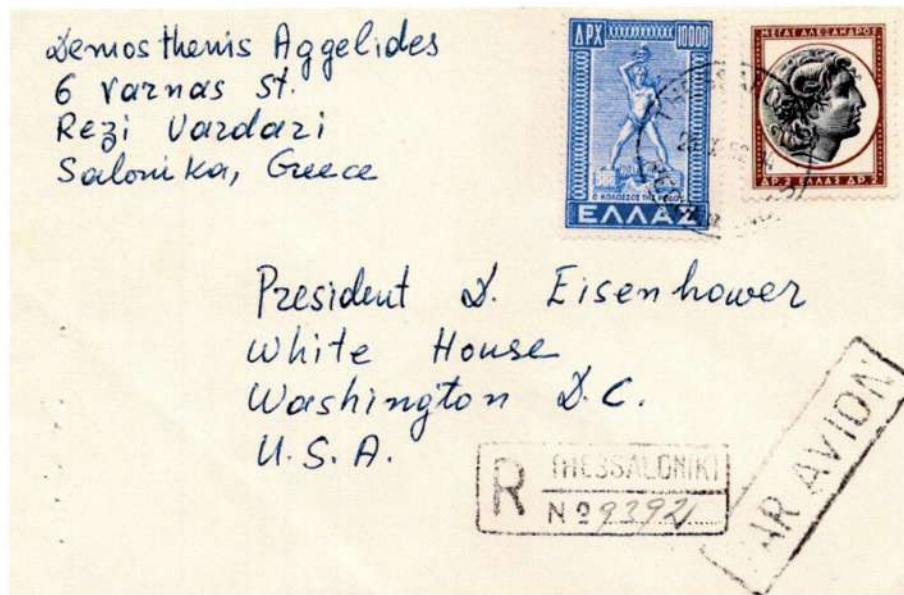

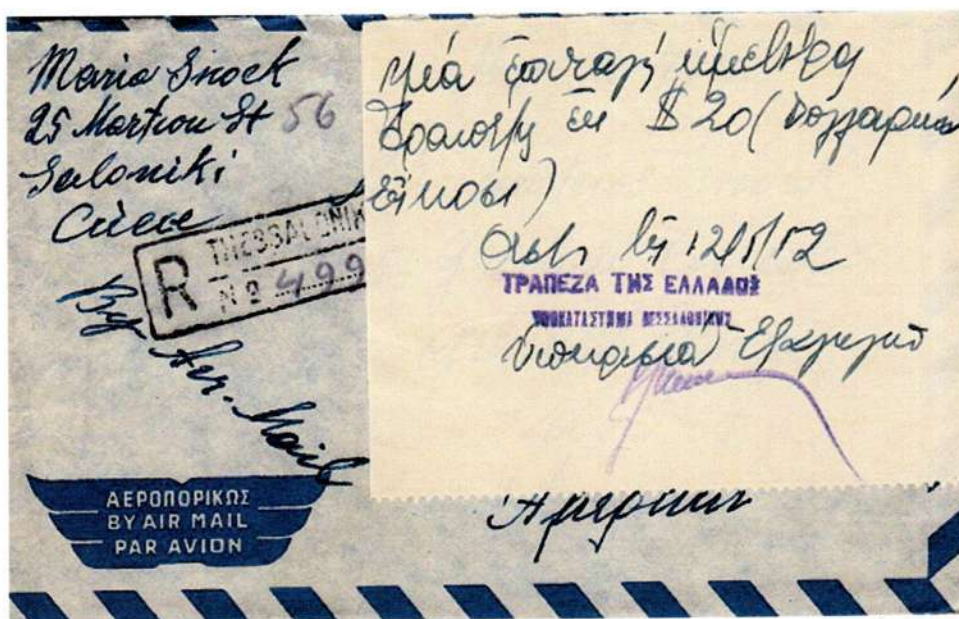

Outgoing registered letters which contained foreign exchange in the form of checks, before being mailed, must have had the approval of the Bank of Greece. They were checked, closed, and a special stamp was placed on the back of the files stating their contents.
